**SUBJECT:** Board of Directors Compensation Increase

**Proposed Motion / Recommendation**

Adopt Resolution No. 26-03, amending Section 21 of the Board Policy Manual to make it consistent with the ordinance approved in January.

Recognize that from and including Wednesday, January 21, 2026, to but **not** including Wednesday, March 18, a total of 56 days – no petition was filed. If no petition is filed by March 21, 2026, the ordinance will take effect on March 22, 2026.

**Policy Implications**

The Community Services District Act provides at Government Code Section 61047 that the Board of Directors of a community services district may provide, by ordinance or resolution, that each of its members may receive compensation in an amount not to exceed \$100 for each day of service, up to a maximum of six days of service per month. Section 61047 also provides that the Board may increase the amount of such compensation (but not the number of meetings) by an ordinance adopted pursuant to Chapter 2 (commencing with Section 20200) of Division 10 of the Water Code.

Water Code Section 20200 defines "water districts" as community services districts. Water Code Section 20201 authorizes water districts, by ordinance, to provide compensation to Board members in an amount not to exceed \$100 per day for each day's attendance at meetings of the Board or for each day's service rendered as a Board member by request of the Board. Section 20201 further authorizes water districts, by ordinance, to increase the compensation received by Board members above \$100 per day. Under Section 20202, the increase may not exceed 5 percent for each calendar year following the operative date of the last adjustment to the compensation, which is received when the ordinance is adopted.

### **Fiscal Implications**

The financial implications will be minimal.

### **Alternatives Considered**

Do not increase Board compensation.

### **Discussion**

Under Water Code Section 20203, an ordinance setting or increasing Board member compensation can only be adopted following a public hearing. Notice of the hearing was published in a newspaper of general circulation pursuant to Section 6066 of the Government Code. Water Code Section 20204 provides that the ordinance becomes effective 60 days from the date of its final passage.

Below is a table showing the steps the District has taken to approve an increase in Director compensation per the above-mentioned requirements.

The notice period commences upon the first day of publication and terminates at the end of the fourteenth day, including therein the first day.</li></ul>
Water Code §§20202 and 20203; Gov't Code §§6066 and 25121	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Not less than 15 days after the commencement of the publication of the notice, the Board conducts a public hearing and adopts an ordinance increasing Director compensation.</li><li>• The ordinance should address compensation for regular meetings, special meetings, committee meetings, and other Director activities.</li></ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The increases may not exceed an amount equal to 5 percent for each calendar year following the operative date of the last adjustment.</li> <li>• The ordinance is signed by the President and attested by the Secretary</li> </ul>

**RESOLUTION NO. 26-03**

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SANTA YNEZ COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT IS AMENDING THE BOARD POLICY MANUAL TO REFLECT INCREASED COMPENSATION FOR MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

**WHEREAS** the Board of Directors (the "Board") of the Santa Ynez Community Services District (the "District") adopted an Amended and Restated Board Policy Manual on November 20, 2019 (the "Policy Manual") to address various legal and procedural matters as they relate to the Board and the conduct of its business, including the payment of compensation to Board members for meeting attendance and other activities; and

**WHEREAS**, a new Section 5 was added to the manual by adoption of Resolution 24-03 on February 21, 2024.

**WHEREAS**, Section 17 of the Policy Manual was amended by a motion of the Board on June 26, 2024.

**WHEREAS**, on January 15, 2025, the Board adopted Ordinance No. O-25-01 to increase the compensation payable to Board members.

**WHEREAS** the Board amended Section 21 of the Policy Manual to make it consistent with the compensation increases that Ordinance No O-25-01 approved.

**WHEREAS**, on January 21, 2026, the Board adopted Ordinance No. O-26-01 to increase the compensation payable to Board members; and

**WHEREAS** the Board desires to amend Section 21 of the Policy Manual to make it consistent with the compensation increases that Ordinance No O-26-01 approved.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Directors of the Santa Ynez Community Services District as follows:

**1. Amendment to Section 21.** The second, third, fourth, and fifth paragraphs under Section 21 of the Policy Manual (Board and Committee Meetings; Additional Services; and Maximum Compensation) are hereby deleted in their entirety and are replaced with the following:

Board and Committee Meetings

The Board holds regular meetings on the third Wednesday of each month and holds special meetings as provided by law. In addition, the Board has established various standing committees to address specific ongoing issues.

It periodically establishes ad hoc committees to address matters not within the purview of the District's standing committees. Subject to the provisions and limitations of this Section, Directors shall be compensated at the rate of \$187.29 for attendance at all regularly scheduled board meetings and special board meetings and at the rate of \$93.64 for attendance at standing committee meetings and ad hoc committee meetings, together with any expenses incident to that.

Additional Services

The Board periodically requests that Directors attend meetings of other agencies and organizations at which matters that pertain to or affect the District are to be discussed and acted upon. Directors render services to the District by attending and participating in such meetings. For all services identified in Section 3, Directors shall be compensated at \$93.64, with any expenses incident to that.

Maximum Compensation

The maximum compensation a Director is entitled to receive for attending Board and committee meetings and rendering other services is \$1,123.67 per month.

**2. Continued Effect.** Except as expressly amended herein, the Policy Manual shall continue in full force and effect.
